When InDidjInUs was created, it was envisioned to be an event that honored the didgeridoo and was intended to bring a deeper appreciation and understanding of this ancient instrument, through workshops and music.

Since its creation in 1996, the InDidjInUs community has grown from an intimate family reunion into a larger, high-energy celebration. With the growth of our community, it became clear that many people longed for the smaller, more intimate gathering. While not mutually exclusive, it's difficult to pack both of these things into a single event on a single weekend. This is why we have chosen to go in both directions, and hold back-to-back events this summer. Now people can choose to go to either the ***Festival***, the ***Conference***, or ***BOTH!*** They are located only about two hours away from each other, in Scio and Tidewater, Oregon, on the second and third weekends of August. We view this as a win/win solution for everyone.

The larger, Festival gathering will satisfy your craving to be in the familiar atmosphere of beautiful Prindel Creek Farm, with great music, dancing, food, vending, and awesome people. While the smaller, more focused Conference will satisfy your desire to connect with beautiful people in a more intimate setting, while taking your understanding and love of the didge to a deeper level.

The Land and Environment

Prindel Creek Farm is a remote and secluded, private venue located on Five Rivers Road, between Alsea and Waldport, Oregon. Camping is available throughout the acres of property and there are level spots in the parking area for those who want to sleep in their vehicles/campers. Prindel Creek Farm is a mixture of meadows, hills, forest and creeks, with uneven terrain. It's beautiful.

What do I need for my stay?

- *Bring clothing and camping supplies for **cool evenings and hot days**. It can cool down to the 40s and night and up into the 90s during the day. It has been known to **rain** during the summer in Oregon, so be prepared for anything.
- *There is **clean drinking water** on site.
- *There are **no private fires** but you may bring your own cook stove if needed.
- ***Meals** are provided but it is a good idea to bring your own food and utensils in cases of dish shortages, food allergies and particular eaters. Grocery stores are an hour or more drive away. There is **no ice** available on site.
- *There will be clean porta potties throughout the property.
- *There is a cool creek for water fun and open grounds for on land fun.
- ***There is no ATM, mobile data, or Wi-Fi available on site so be prepared for/with CASH.**

Food

There will be a vegetarian kitchen serving meals throughout the weekend. Meals are included in your membership purchase. The closest grocery store is nearly an hour one way. There are some plates, utensils and cups available on site, but you should consider bringing your own. There will a dish washing station available for you to wash your own dishes. Volunteers are always needed! Both food and monetary contributions are welcome.
